Registration


Registration opens for Season 12 on April 1, 2021

Who is it for?

Storm Athletics has teams available for both boys and girls of any skill level from ages 3-18. Every athlete makes a team.

When

Our summer schedule runs from May through August and features both tumbling and cheer stunting classes for 1 hour each, every week. We also have other cheerleading skill classes available throughout the summer for an extra fee.





Mandatory Dates

Team placement evaluations will take place at the end of August. If this date does not work for you, please make sure that you plan with us for a private evaluation.

Our mandatory practices begin Tuesday, September 7, 2020. Mandatory team practices vary in time from 1 hour to 3 hours (depending on age/level) and are multiple times per week (every Sunday and 1-2 weeknights) along with one hour of mandatory tumbling practice on Sundays. A detailed team schedule will be released immediately following team placements.

Choreography for full year teams will tentatively be September 18-20, 2020. Exact dates and times will be announced following team placements. Any absences from choreography will not be allowed. Tiny Cheer choreography will take place in October and will be done during regularly scheduled practice times.

This schedule is only temporary and final scheduled will be based on announcement of competition dates. Unfortunately, due to Covid, competition companies are still finishing their 2020-21 season and have not released their final dates for the next season.

Many competition companies have implemented a Stay-to-Play policy which requires **all** athletes and coaches to make rooming reservations through a housing company designated by the competition. Do **NOT** make arrangements on your own. Any athlete that does not follow this policy will cause their team to be disqualified from competing (per Stay-to-Play rules).



FUNDRAISING

We try our best to accommodate families and offer discounts for multiple siblings. Every family can participate in fundraising, some families do not pay anything out of pocket after registration costs. We offer fundraising once a month and can provide you materials to seek individual sponsors at any time.

Your monthly fees, tumbling, spirit wear, travel expenses and all other costs can be paid for with your fundraising money. We keep individual accounts for each athlete so that the money you raise is set aside for your child. We do many fundraisers that the athletes can do on their own, such as: car washes, bake sales, 50/50 raffles and so on.

Our best fundraiser by far is working the concession stands at Darien Lake concerts. This must be done by the parents or any family member 18 and over. Many families during our previous seasons were able to pay for their entire season costs with this fundraiser. We have had families in the past pay for their full season of cheer by working concerts. Adults must take a training through Darien Lake in order to work concerts. There is no fee for this training or parking at the venue while working.

There are 4-5 fundraisers per season that are gym fundraisers. Since we are a non-profit, these fundraisers help to purchase new equipment and supplies for the gym. If you choose not to participate in these fundraisers, there will be a buy-out option offered.

While fundraising to cover your expenses is not mandatory, it is a fantastic opportunity to make the season affordable. You may also choose to pay for all season costs out of pocket.
